

Key Responsibilities

Opportunities will vary based on your interests, skills, and availability. Responsibilities may include:

Planning Committee Roles:

- **Programs:** Event planning, organization, logistics, administrative tasks (filing, scanning, participant database management, supply upkeep and inventory tracking etc.).
- Marketing: Promoting the program, including: graphic design, photography, videography, social media, . press releases, email blasts, etc.
- **Community Outreach:** Partnership building with businesses, organizations, schools, and individuals to share ٠ program flyer and additional information. Includes phone and email outreach, flyer distribution, face-to-face meetings.
- **Finance:** Securing event sponsorships, grant applications, managing event budget and program finances.

Planning committee volunteers may need to attend weekly committee meetings or as scheduled.
